

# MOUNTAINEERING

The whole trip was about mountaineering, in all its forms and flavours.

The following is a list of significant first ascents claimed. The locational references are as per the expeditions own 1:50,000 maps. For reference purposes, the datum for the altitude of Base Camp was 976m, and the high point, or "water"shed, of the Korridoren was about 1,000m.

- 20) **Lookout Point – 202m – behind Coastal Camp – Ref 950.501**  
11<sup>th</sup>/12<sup>th</sup> August 2004 – By every member. This is the obvious peak that will have been climbed by every expeditioner or kayaker setting foot on Milne Land!
- 21) **Bimble Peak – 265m – North of Constablepynt**  
13<sup>th</sup> August 2004 – Liam & AndyBl. Again the obvious peak worthy of a stroll and an ascent from the airport!
